

**Jackson Water Precinct Annual Meeting

**Robert Flammia called the meeting to order at 6:PM**

Robert Flammia called for Votes:

**Article 01 To Choose all necessary Precinct Officers**

- a. Moderator for one year: Kevin nominated Robert Flammia, Michele 2<sup>nd</sup>, all in favor - passed
- b. Clerk/Treasurer for one year: Prior to vote Jeanette Heidmann questioned the title of Clerk/Treasurer. As no check signing or banking is involved title will be changed to clerk only. Kevin nominated Kathleen L. Flammia, Michele 2<sup>nd</sup>, all in favor - passed
- c. Commissioner for three years Kevin nominated Karl Meyers, Michele Pratt 2<sup>nd</sup>, all in favor - passed
- d. Auditor for one year: Kevin nominated Roberts & Green PLLC, Michele 2<sup>nd</sup>, all in favor - passed

**Article 02 Bedrock Well Permitting**

To see if Jackson Water Precinct will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of fifty thousand (\$50,000.00) for the purpose of getting our bedrock well permitted with NHDES and all costs incidental and related thereto, of such sum to be raised through the issuance of bonds or notes under and in compliance with the Municipal Finance Act, RSA 33:1 et seq., as amended; to authorize the Commissioners to apply for, obtain and accept federal, state or other aid, if any, authorize the Commissioners to issue, negotiate, sell and deliver said bonds and notes and to determine the rate in interest thereon and the maturity and other terms thereof, and to authorize the Commissioners to take any other action or to pass any other vote relative thereto, Commissioners favor. Three-fifths 3/5 ballot vote required.

**Article 03 Operating Budget**

To raise and appropriate \$414,563.00 as necessary to defray Precinct cost for the ensuing year and to make appropriations for the same:

**Article 04 To Provide Hydrant Serve**

To see if the Precinct will vote to raise and appropriate \$6,300.00 to provide hydrant service to The town of Jackson with \$6,300.00 to be reimbursed by the town for said services. Commissioners favor. Ballots collected and counted - 5 Yes and 0 No - Passed

**Article 05 To act upon other business**

To act upon any other business which may legally come before this meeting.

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During the reading of the articles Jeanette Heidmann and Jean French requested more detailed information on the Operating Budget. It was discussed that during the Budgeting process and Open Budgeting meeting the details were available to anyone who wanted to review them. It was determined that Francine would email both a detailed budget (emails were exchanged). A question was raised as to where we post advance notice for our meetings. We reviewed that we are in the process of developing our own website which prior to this website were posting it on the Town website, notices were posted at the required billboards.

Jeanette Heidmann questioned what determined who could vote on Articles for Water Precinct? General discussion was that if you live within the Water Precinct District and are voting age (18) you were eligible to vote. Another question was if there are four people of voting age living in a resident within the Water Precinct District, how many were eligible to vote? It was determined that all parties living in the household within the Water Precinct District and voting age were eligible to vote.

Robert asked if there were any further questions or input and there were no further questions.

Robert Flammia closed the Annual Meeting at 6:40 PM.
